

Eligibility Details for 2020 FASPE Programs

FASPE welcomes applications from individuals at all institutions who meet the requirements below. There are no nationality, residency or citizenship requirements for applicants.

Business

FASPE Business applicants must be actively pursuing a career in business and fit into one of the following three categories: 1) be enrolled in an MBA or MSc program at the time of their application; 2) have completed their MBA or MSc degree between May 2018 and January 2020 and be working as a business professional; or 3) have completed an undergraduate degree in any field between May 2015 and May 2017 and be working as a business professional.

Journalism

FASPE Journalism applicants must be interested in journalism as a career and fit into one of the following two categories: 1) be enrolled in a graduate program of any kind and planning to work as a journalist; 2) be working as a journalist with an undergraduate degree in any field received between May 2014 and May 2019 or a graduate degree in any field received between May 2018 and January 2020.

Law

FASPE Law applicants must fit into one of the following three categories: 1) be enrolled in a JD or LLM program (or equivalent program); 2) be working in the legal profession (including a clerkship) at the time of their application and have received a JD or LLM between May 2018 and January 2020; or 3) be working as a trainee or similar position after having completed their requisite legal training in the applicable jurisdiction.

Medical

FASPE Medical applicants must fit into one of following three categories: 1) be enrolled in an MD or DO program (or equivalent) at the time of their application and anticipate completion of at least one clinical year prior to the start of the fellowship; or 2) have an MD or DO (or equivalent) and be working towards a subsequent bioethics, public health or doctoral degree; or 3) be enrolled in a residency program.

Seminary

FASPE Seminary applicants must either be enrolled in graduate school preparing for work as a religious leader at the time of application or they must be working as clergy with a relevant graduate degree received between May 2018 and January 2020. Those applying as students may be studying at a seminary, divinity school, rabbinical school, Muslim chaplaincy program or other graduate program related to religious OR theological training.

FASPE programs are non-denominational. Candidates of all religious, ethnic, cultural and national backgrounds are encouraged to apply.
