We turn to visual artspecifically to artists who collaborated with the Nazi regime for micro-case studies of the otherand in particular the creation of monsters whose threat justifies their destruction. As Reinhold Heller put it, "Without the pejorative Jewish image, the German ideal could not be purposeively visualized." We will discuss how such artistic examples of creating legitimacy for genocide stand parallel to examples of religious professionals who lent their roles and expertise to the construction of Jews-as-(Monstrous)-Others in ways that laid the groundwork for the Holocaust agenda of "exterminating" Jews. Or, to look and the process of othering from a different direction, Hhow might the act of "othering" and its extreme form of constucting others as monsters participate in efforts to avoid identifying with the perpetrators of injustice?
