

2025 FASPE Business Fellowship Eligibility Requirements

FASPE Business applicants must be actively pursuing a career in business and fit into one of the following three categories: 1) be enrolled in an MBA or related graduate program with a maximum of 5 years of prior experience at the time of their application; OR 2) have completed their MBA or related graduate degree and be working as a business professional with a maximum of 5 years of experience at the time of application; OR 3) have completed an undergraduate degree and be working as a business professional, with a maximum of 5 years of professional experience at the time of application.

FASPE seeks Business Fellows with diverse interests and backgrounds, including those pursuing careers in any business sector, at non-profits, at start-ups, in consulting, and in other business settings.

FASPE seeks Fellows at a formative stage of their professional lives, who are open-minded and self-reflective, demonstrate leadership capabilities, and possess the potential of having influence in their fields. FASPE selects its Fellows on the basis of their academic background, personal and professional experiences, capacity for leadership, and ability to contribute to the Fellowship program and the alumni community. FASPE values and seeks to create inclusive environments, and welcomes applicants of all religious, political, and socioeconomic backgrounds as well as gender identities. FASPE seeks Fellows who are interested in engaging in discussions with their co-Fellows and faculty, and who have the intellectual and emotional maturity to discuss difficult and controversial issues responsibly and respectfully in small group settings.
